Purposes and legal basis of data processing

The purpose of collecting your personal data is your application process. We will therefore only use your applicant data for the purpose of processing your application process. The legal basis for this data processing results from § 26 BDSG-Neu and Art. 88 DSGVO.

Storage duration or criteria for determining the duration

We save your personal data upon receipt of your application. If there is a recruitment, we save your applicant data within the statutory retention periods until after the relevant employment relationship has ended. If we reject your application, we will save your applicant data for six months after the rejection of your application, unless you give us your consent to it being stored for a longer period.

Recipients or categories of recipients of the data (if data is transmitted)

As part of the processing, your personal data will be transmitted to the responsible specialist departments. There is no transmission to third parties.

Information on the rights of those affected

You have the right to request confirmation from the controller as to whether personal data concerning you are being processed; if this is the case, you have the right to information about this personal data and the information detailed in Art. 15 GDPR.

You have the right to request that the controller immediately correct any incorrect personal data relating to you and, if necessary, complete incomplete personal data (Art. 16 GDPR).

You have the right to request that the person responsible delete your personal data immediately, provided that one of the reasons listed in Art. 17 GDPR applies, e.g. B. if the data is no longer required for the purposes pursued (right to deletion), unless there are legal retention or archiving periods to prevent this.

You have the right to request the controller to restrict processing if one of the conditions listed in Art. 18 GDPR is met, e.g. B. if you have objected to processing, for the duration of the review by the controller.

You have the right to request that the personal data relating to you, which you have provided to a person responsible, be transferred to another person responsible (Art. 20 GDPR).

You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data at any time for reasons arising from your particular situation. The controller will then no longer process the personal data, unless he can demonstrate compelling legitimate grounds for the processing that outweigh your interests, rights and freedoms, or the processing serves to assert, exercise or defend legal claims (Art. 21 GDPR).

You have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority. You can exercise this right with a supervisory authority in the Member State of your residence, your place of work or the place of the alleged violation.

Before you contact the responsible supervisory authority with a complaint, we would like to ask you to clarify this matter with our data protection officer.
